## **Police accepting applications for "Are You OK?" program**

The **Garden City Police Department** is now accepting applications for the "Are You OK?" program.

"Are You OK?" is a telephone reassurance service offered for free to elderly, homebound or physically disabled Garden City residents. Participants in the program are called each day at a pre-selected time to check on their welfare. The program is computer-controlled and monitored constantly by the Garden City Police Department.

The system requires a coded "OK" response from the call recipient. When a subscriber answers the phone, the system accepts the call and moves on to the next subscriber. Improper responses, or no response, will initiate an alarm on the system and can generate notifications for up to four phone numbers and two pagers. These pre-determined numbers can be for family members, neighbors and department members. Calling schedules can vary from day to day and time to time, depending on the needs of the recipient. Applicants are required to have a working telephone.
